Andris Zabrauskis was born in 1961. Since 1994 he served as an assistant professor of building acoustics at the Riga Technical University, Latvia. He received a building engineering diploma (specialization – acoustics) in 1984 and MSc from the same University in 1994.

He has worked as leading acoustics engineer, head of acoustics division and chief acoustician of Latvian State Building Design Institute „Pilsetprojekts” from 1984 - 1994. He is author of more than 300 building acoustical designs and solutions in Baltic states, as well as an author of more than 20 papers in Latvian, English and Russian. His main research interests are currently hall acoustics, special sound insulating systems and noise control.

He has served as president and vice-president of the Latvian Acoustics Association (LAA) from 1998 - 2004. He is a fellow of LAA and EAA (European Acoustics Association), and expert of the EAA committee „Room and Building Acoustics”.
